



## English Language -Entry Requirements- [Standard 2]

### 1.0 Purpose

MCOHB needs to be satisfied that the student's English language proficiency, qualifications and experience are appropriate for the course. Students planning to undertake a program at MCOHB must meet the relevant English language entry requirements of the course.

MCOHB have in place, and follow, documented procedures for assessing whether a student's qualifications, experience and English language proficiency are appropriate for the course for which enrolment is sought.

All international students must demonstrate their English language competency by one of the following means:

- academic study to at least an equivalent to an Australian Year 12 qualification or overseas equivalent where English was the language of instruction
- IELTS 5.5 (no band less than 5.0)
- English Language Intensive Courses for Overseas Students (ELICOS) Applies to stand-alone English language courses that lead to a certificate I, II, III or IV, or that result in no formal Australian award.

MCOHB may still assess whether the student's English language proficiency is appropriate for the course for which enrolment is sought, should it feel that the student's English does not meet the entry requirement so it may adopt another mode of English testing that satisfies the college.

**All English language entry requirements are subject to the Department of Immigration and Citizenship's requirements.**

For MCOHB Certificates and Diploma level applications IELTS General 5.5 with no band below 5.0 is acceptable to meet the English language requirements to enter MCOHB.
